Esteban,

I set up the form to do a redirect and noticed a post is necessary since we are posting within our own form. If we posted directly to you we could not do any validation on our join page.

I was going to set up a fake form post, but you guys are using a reserved form variable name. "submit"

So a fake form post can't be done.

We can do 1 of 3 things

- a) Change to a GET but all the variables will be visible in the url and we will be passing sensitive customer information.
- b) You guys will have to change the name of submit to something else. I usually use the word "action" to avoid colliding with submit.
- c) Do a background POST handshake where I send the data to you on a POST, and you return a variable that I pass on the GET. ("Probably the safest"), along with a confirmation.

It would work like this:

Customer signs up I POST to a determined url your fields you sent me via a back end url, not over the browser.

You pass me back an alphanumeric ID that is assigned to that customer.

I then pass that back to you via a header redirect.

I say alphanumeric because if its just a numeric id it will be easy for people to alter it.

If you would like I can pass you the session id we create on our end. These are always unique and tie directly into our database model.

The session id is the actual php session id that is generated so your guys should know the length of it, and then you guys can pass a

success message to me and I would then redirect the customer.

Let me know what works for your guys.

All are easily deployable on my end.

We are also going to need another post on your end later on to pass back the username and password. I will set this up either tonight or early in the morning tomorrow.
